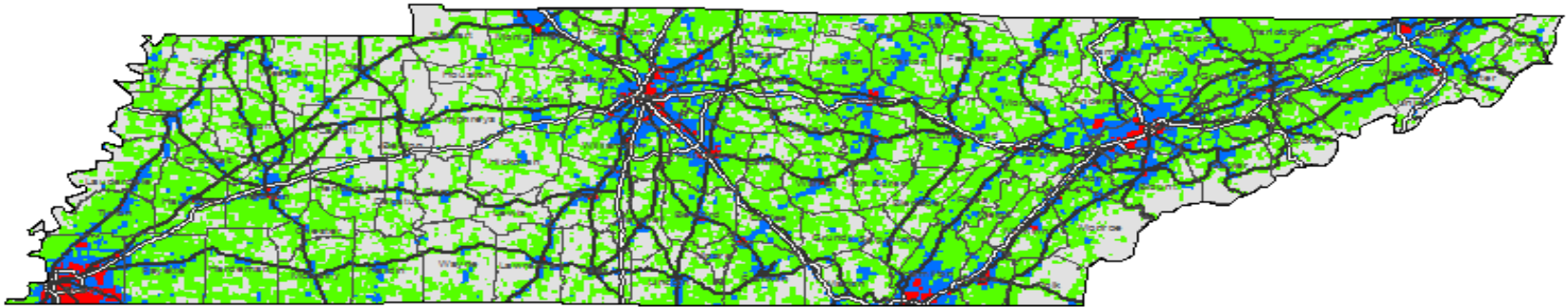

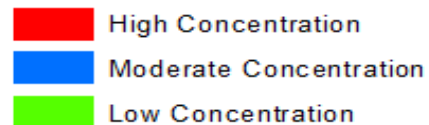
Current Timeline

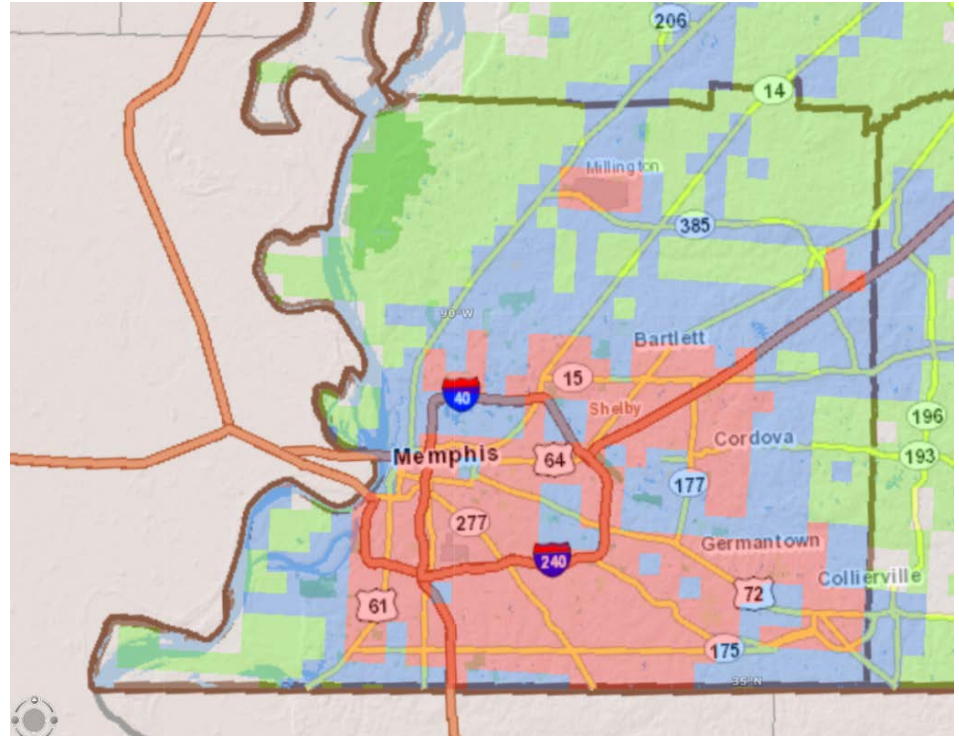

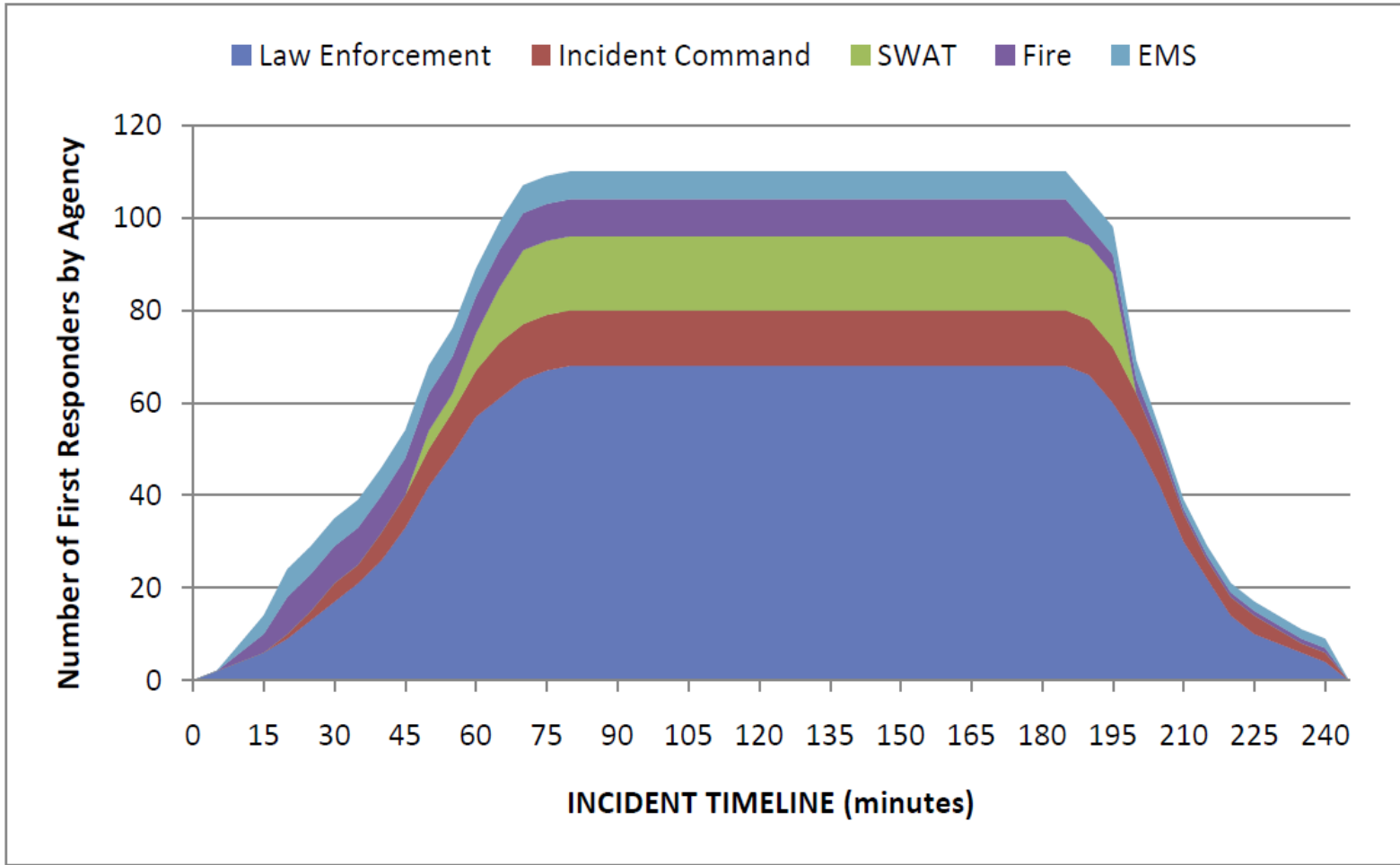
